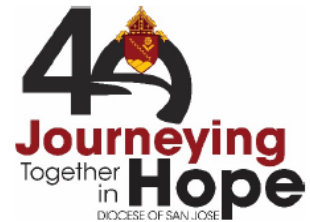

**From our Pastor**  
**Annual Diocesan Appeal**

January 24, 2021



Dear Parishioner,

Pope Francis recently spoke about the need for unity in today's Church. In his homily, he said, "The Lord did not command us to like one another, but to love one another. He is the one who unites us, without making us alike." This year we celebrate the 40th Jubilee for the Diocese of San Jose. Pope John Paul II established the Diocese of San Jose in 1981 and for forty years we have journeyed as people of faith throughout Santa Clara County. We have come together from all walks of life to express God's love, justice, and mercy through worship, outreach and formation. The Annual Diocesan Appeal for the Diocese of San Jose provides financial support for ministries and services for all Catholics in our diocese.

I want to take this opportunity to thank you for your generous support of the Annual Diocesan Appeal in previous years. Your generosity toward this year's campaign, *Journeying Together in Hope*, will provide essential support to St. Joseph Cathedral Basilica and other parishes throughout our local church. The appeal supports various ministries including faith formation, youth and young adult ministry, outreach to incarcerated persons, and tuition assistance for children in our Catholic elementary schools.

The ADA also supports the formation of seminarians and future permanent deacons. Funds likewise offset the cost of ongoing clergy formation, the tribunal, and support the Institute for Leadership in Ministry (ILM).

St. Joseph Cathedral also benefits directly from your support of the ADA. A portion of my salary is reimbursed for my work in the Diocese. As the Cathedral Parish we receive an additional \$150,000 in subsidy which supplements priest salaries. All monies collected over our parish goal of \$110,000 will be rebated directly back to our parish to use for our ministries and other parish needs. Even if you have not pledged in the past, please prayerfully consider supporting this mission.

I am confident that this year's ADA will be another success and a testimony of our commitment not only to St. Joseph's, but for the Church's important work in Santa Clara Valley. With your continued support and dedication we will continue to Journey Together in Hope.

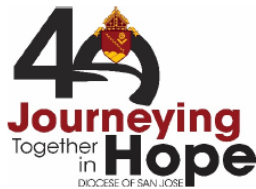

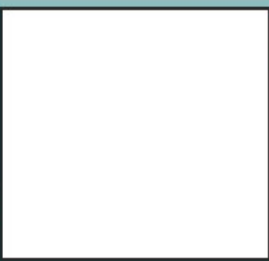
